

## **Infirmary Charge Policy for Incomplete Medical Information**

Stated requirements in the St. John's Military School Omnibus indicate the following must be provided **PRIOR** to entrance into SJMS:

KSHSAA Physical Examination completed and signed by a MD, DO, DC, or RPA \*Per Kansas Statute K.S.A. 72-5214 requiring a health assessment prior to enrollment to include a health history, physical examination and such screening tests as are medically indicated.

Dental Card completed and signed by a Dentist \*Per Kansas Statute K.S.A. 72-5214

Immunization Records – current with complete (month/day/year) dates \* Per Kansas Statute K.S.A. 72-5209 requires appropriate certification from a physician or health department that cadet has received such tests and inoculations as are deemed necessary. As an alternative a cadet may provide (1) an annual written statement signed by a Medical Doctor (M.D.) or Doctor of Osteopathy (D.O.) stating the physical condition of the cadet to be such that the tests or inoculations would seriously endanger the life or health of the cadet OR (2) a written statement signed by one parent or guardian that the cadet is an adherent of a religious denomination whose religious teachings are opposed to such tests or inoculations.

If the above physical examination, dental, and/or immunization requirements have not been completed as per the State of Kansas Statutes, the SJMS Infirmery Staff will schedule an appointment to have the physical examination, dental examination, and/or immunizations completed.

Due to additional costs in processing medical appointments, associated paperwork, and extra time and effort required by the nursing staff to make these arrangements an added charge of \$50 will be charged to your cadets Incidental Account. This charge does not include the cost of round trip transportation via taxi, the medical appointment, immunizations or other costs incurred during appointments.

This policy only pertains to incomplete medical information as stated above.
