



ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF MAJOR OFFENSES STATEMENT

MAJOR OFFENSES STATEMENT (Please read carefully and sign)

We, parent and cadet, understand that cadets will be dismissed from St. John's Military School if they are found guilty of any of the following serious offenses:

1. Possession, use, misuse or traffic of illicit drugs, narcotics, marijuana, alcoholic beverages or inhalants.

NOTE: To support a drug free environment, cadets are subject to urinalysis testing under reasonable suspicion at the parent's expense. Refusal to take the test will constitute admission of guilt and appropriate disciplinary action will be taken.

2. Possession of drug paraphernalia e.g., hypodermic needles, marijuana pipes, "roach clips", etc.
3. Sexual misconduct
4. Physical hazing or assault of another cadet
5. Unauthorized possession of a firearm or other lethal weapon
6. Violation of civil law
7. Any act that brings discredit to St. John's Military School
8. Honor offenses - see class one offenses in Cadet Handbook (20) (21) (12)

We, parent and cadet, understand that a cadet may be subject to dismissal or lesser penalties if found guilty of any of the following serious offenses:

1. Suicidal or self-mutilating behavior
2. Disgraceful or refractory conduct; includes sexual harassment
3. Absent without leave (AWOL) for five days or more
4. Willful disobedience to a member of the staff/faculty
5. Possession of exploding fireworks, smoke bombs, ammunition or explosives
6. Unauthorized possession of a master key, key, or combination to another cadet's room or locker
7. Tampering with door locks/unauthorized entry into school buildings
8. Tampering with vending machines
9. Indecent exposure
10. Manifest indifference to or inability to adjust to the routine of St. John's Military School
11. False statements to civil authorities
